This week, the school entertained colleagues from Challenge Partners. Challenge Partners is a community of over 475 schools in England who support each other to drive school improvement for all children. As part of the service they provide, they send senior colleagues from all over the country to review schools and provide feedback on how they are doing. As part of this review process, we welcomed 6 senior colleagues from around the country into Preston Manor School for 3 days to see how we do things and provide us with critical feedback.

I am absolutely delighted to share some of the feedback that our colleagues shared with us about our children at the Lower School. Between them, the 3 colleagues who joined us in the Lower School, have been in over 400 schools across the country and they were absolutely **'blown away'** by our children.

- 3. Are polite and welcoming**
- 4. Work so well together in class**
- 5. Are confident and articulate speakers**
- 6. Have excellent learning behaviours and push themselves to succeed in their learning**

To hear this wonderful feedback from colleagues who have seen so many schools fills me with immense pride and I just wanted to share this with all our parents. It is the trust and relationships that we have in each other that allows our children to thrive, and thrive they do.



Added to this, our Year 5 children went on a trip on Tuesday to a Mandir and a Gudwara, and they received similar praise from the people who they came into contact with at these places of worship. Our Year 5 children were commended on their behaviour and attitude and one lady made a point of telling the teachers that **she was really impressed with the children's behaviour and respectful manner. She said that it was lovely to see children who showed such a sweet and respectful demeanor.**

Again, this feedback is so wonderful to hear and I couldn't help but share it with you all.

I would like to sincerely thank all our parents and carers who work so well with us, who support us and who believe in what the school has been growing over the past 4 years.
