**Sufra North West London** is a community organisation which provides a wide range of services, including a Food Bank and a free Friday evening meal.

Our services provide a life-line for people in crisis, including families living in extreme poverty and people who are vulnerable, homeless, or socially isolated.

We provide our guests with the food and support they urgently need to survive; empower them to learn new skills and improve their wellbeing; and help them to become financially stable, by addressing benefit problems and by providing help to get into work.

Our food bank provides emergency supplies of essential food and toiletries to people experiencing acute crisis. We are open on Wednesday and Sunday from 12.00 to 3pm.

If you are in need, you are welcome to visit us. You will need a voucher, which you can obtain by phoning Brent Council Welfare Team before coming. If they assess that you are eligible, they will email a voucher to us. If you prefer, you can come on **Wednesday** and we will phone for you.
