### English

**Genres:** Recounts, Character and setting description, Diary entry

**Reading:** Apply their growing knowledge of new words to read aloud and to understand the meaning of new terms that they meet.

**Writing and spelling:** Revising plurals, using silent letters, word endings, descriptive language and homophones.

Write legibly, fluently and with increasing speed.

**Grammar and punctuation:** fronted adverbials, complex sentences, conjunctions, adverbial phrases, expanded noun phrases, sentence starters, paragraphs, modal verbs, relative pronouns, brackets and clauses.

**Key vocabulary:**

Adverbs, adjectives, parenthesis, clause, cohesion.

**Number:** Place value - using number lines, rounding and mental maths, Column addition and subtraction - using 4 digits and more, Multiply and divide by 10, 100, 1000, Read and write and compare decimals and fractions.

**Measurement:** Convert between different units of metric measure, including length, weight, capacity and time, solve problems using different measurements.

**Statistics:** Interpret information presented in a line graph, complete, read and interpret information in tables, including timetables.

**Key vocabulary:** rounding, estimating, terms relating to addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
