## Remote Learning for 'Bubbles' of Children or During a Lockdown

It may be the case that in the coming weeks and months a whole 'bubble' of children will be sent home to self-isolate following positive Covid cases. This may be a whole class or a whole year group of children. It is also possible that all children may have to learn remotely during a local or national lockdown.

If your child is part of a 'bubble' of children who have all been sent home to self-isolate, class teachers will be live teaching English and Maths lessons daily on Google Meets.

If they are well enough to do so, your child must watch these sections of the lesson live and ask questions to teachers to get further support with their learning.

Children will then be set further tasks to complete for the remainder of each lesson, for example an extended writing task or questions to answer which will check their understanding of the lesson content.

Children must upload their completed learning using the Google classroom and teachers will provide feedback to children on key pieces of learning using the feedback function on Google classroom. If your child is finding it difficult to access a particular task, please ask your child to email their class teacher using their school email address.

If you do not have access to a laptop/computer/tablet, printed learning will be posted to you as soon as it is possible to do so.
