### Geography

Our world is a very interesting place. We can describe different places with their human and physical features.

### Human features:

A human feature is something man-made or it was made by a human being.

**Key words** city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour, shop, roads

### Physical features:

A physical feature is something which is natural – it happens naturally.

**Key words** natural, beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season, weather

**LONDON** – Physical features include the wonderful River Thames, mostly flat lands and a temperate climate with mild summers and cool winters.

Its human features include many famous landmarks in this fabulous city, such as Tower Bridge, Big Ben and the Tower of London.



**GRENADA** – Physical features include the mountains (St. Catherine), volcanoes, hills, valleys and coastal plains.

Its human features include a population of 112,003 people and they have many factories and shops that make clothing and nutmeg.



**INDIA** – Physical features include cold mountains (like the Himalayan Mountains), the sandy Indian Desert, tropical islands (like Lakshadweep) and hot and humid plains (Ganges Plain).

Its human features include a population of 16.8 million people. In the cities, cows are allowed to roam freely through the streets, which often causes traffic jams! A famous attraction is the Taj Mahal.
