Use verbs to make up his/her own phrase or short sentences to express his/her thoughts aloud about stories or their experiences.

Write caption/key words or short phrases using the graphemes that he/she already knows.

Describe feelings about being at school.

To read and write familiar and unfamiliar words using sounds already taught (set 1, set 2 and set 3-phonics)

Key vocabulary: verbs, experiences, stories, settings, graphemes, suffixes, regular, plural, noun

Science

Animals including humans (All about me)- Senses

We will name identify and draw basic body parts and associate body parts with different senses. With this we will use ideas to gather answers to questions in order to gather data.

Key vocabulary:

Eyes, nose, mouths, ears, smell, taste, touch, hear, see.

Topic: Geography: where do I live?

Develop knowledge of the location of significant places in the children's own local area. Use simple observation and fieldwork skills to study their immediate surroundings.

Discuss the importance of an address. Look at aerial maps as a way to see local areas. Interpret and eventually create symbolic maps of the local area. Learn about cardinal directions (North, East, South and West).
