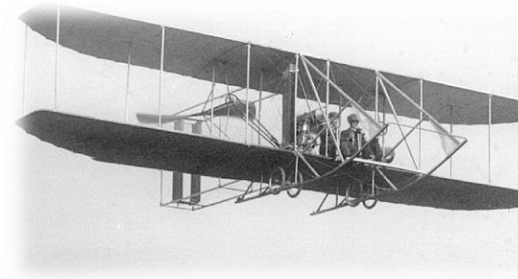
Cars

- The Benz Patent-Motorwagen was built in 1885 by Karl Benz.
- The world's first production **automobile**.
- The Benz Patent-Motorwagen was a three-wheeled automobile with an engine at the back of the car.
- The cost of the vehicle was only approximately £150.



Clothes

- Children in the Victorian times (1880) having a school photograph taken. This is about 140 years ago!
- School uniforms were made of **cotton** by the parents.



Aeroplanes

- The first plane was **invented** by the Wright brothers in December 1903 (approx. 116 years ago).
- The Kitty Hawk was the name of this, their first successful aeroplane.
- The aeroplane was made of wood and canvas. The pilot flew the plane using two rudders and string. Nobody else could sit on the plane!
