Dear Parent/Carer

I hope that you have a good few weeks since I last wrote to you. It has been an incredibly busy few weeks at our school with Open Evenings, Open mornings, various welcome evenings for the parents of our Upper School students as well as interviews for a Deputy Headteacher at the Upper School.

Our open day and evening events went extremely well and we were joined by many families to have a look around our fantastic school.
