

# Questions to ask your child when reading:

### Before reading a new book:

Why did you choose this book?

Who is the author?

Have you read any other books by this author?

Who is the illustrator/publisher?

Is the book fiction or non-fiction? How do you know?

What do you notice on the front cover?

Shall we read the blurb together?

What do you think might happen in this book? Why?

## Before continuing the same book:

Where in the book did we get up to?
What's happened in the book so far?
Can you summarise what you've read so far?
What do you think might happen next? Why?
What did the word ..... mean?

### Whilst reading:

What sort of character is....? Are they cruel/kind/sneaky?
What impression do you get of this character? Why?
Where is the story set?
What happened on this page?
Can you summarise what just happened?
How do you think this character feels? Why?
How would you feel if you were this character?
What does the word .... mean? How do you know?
What do you think might happen on the next page/in the next chapter? Why?
Why is this word written in bold/italics?
What do you think the author is trying to show us here?
Does this remind you of anyone/anything? Why?

# After reading:

Did you en joy the part we read today? Why?

What happened in the part we read today?

Can you summarise what happened in our reading today?

What was your favourite part of what we just read?

Were there any words/phrases you really liked? Why?

Has your opinion changed of any characters?

Did anything happen that you weren't expecting? Why?

Who would you recommend this book to? Why?

What do you think might happen next?
