





Key vocabulary — movement, technique, expression, performance.

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English- Genres: Shakespeare — The children will be writing a play script, monologue and newspaper report. Reading: The children will apply their growing knowledge of new words to read aloud and to understand the meaning of new terms that they meet. Writing and spelling: The children will learn to write legibly, fluently and with increasing speed. Grammar and punctuation: They will be taught about subordinate clauses, paragraphs, modal verbs, relative pronouns and clauses, metaphors and similes Key vocabulary: Adverb, myths, action, adventure, personification, setting, genre	Maths-Number- The children will learnt about place value Fractions- They will be multiplying fractions. Decimals- The children will learnt about percentages, fractions, and converting between the three. Solving word problems The children will be using addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. Using written methods for multiplication and division. Measurement: They will calculate perimeter of regular and irregular shapes & area of squares and rectangles. Statistics: The children will interpret information in line graphs, complete, read and interpret information in tables, including timetables. Key vocabulary: fraction, decimals, number, division.	The children will explore changes of state by comparing and grouping objects based on their properties. They will identify materials that are soluble or insoluble in water, and identify irreversible changes. Key vocabulary:

They will be learning about what happens to the Soul when you die and how the different religions commemorate funerals.
