

Curriculum Overview - Year 6 – Summer 1 2024

<p><u>English</u> <u>Text:</u> This half term, the children will write using a variety of stimuli, including pictures, short videos and extracts of texts.</p> <p><u>Genres:</u> Over the course of the half term, the children will write a formal letter, a short story and a description based on the various stimuli they are given.</p> <p><u>Reading:</u> This half-term, the children will be preparing for their SATs tests. Alongside reading a class text, the children will practise answering questions based on past Year 6 reading texts within a set time frame.</p> <p><u>Grammar and punctuation:</u> This half term, the children will focus on revising all the punctuation taught so far, including passive voice, semi-colons, progressive tenses and subordinate clauses.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> <u>Revision for Year 6 SATs</u> This half-term, the children will be reviewing all their learning so far in maths. This revision will take them all the way back to the maths learning they did in Years 3, 4 and 5, as well as their learning from this year. They will practise answering problem solving questions using their knowledge from different areas of maths.</p> <p><u>Arithmetic:</u> Throughout the half-term, the children will continue to revise all their arithmetic learning in preparation for their SATs tests.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> This half term, the children's learning will focus on animals including humans. The children will identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system and they will describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. The children will also describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans, before recognising the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.</p> <p><u>Key vocabulary:</u> heart, oxygenated, deoxygenated, valve, blood vessel, vein, artery, impact, nutrients, water, circulatory system</p>
<p><u>Music</u> The next topic for Music lessons is 'Class Awards.'</p> <p><u>Modern Foreign Languages</u> This half-term, the children will continue with their Spanish learning with Mr. Montagut.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> This half-term, the children will be looking at the environmental impact of industrial activity, pollution and climate change. They will consider the ways these factors impact our planet and ways we can combat some of the effects they cause.</p>	<p><u>Art and Design</u> This half-term, the children's DT learning will focus on sculpture and 3D art. In this topic, the children will be documenting their memories of their time at primary school.</p>
<p><u>Religious Education</u> The topic this half-term is, 'Why is there suffering - part 2.'</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u> The topic this half-term is being responsible. The children in Year 6 will be focusing on stealing.</p>	<p><u>PE</u> The children will be continuing with their outdoor PE learning on a Thursday and they will continue with their indoor PE learning on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.</p>
