Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Pedestrian and Cycle Zone for Carlton Avenue East, Princess Avenue, Bowling Green Court and Elmstead Avenue

I have very recently been made aware of the fact that Brent Council is going to implement a Pedestrian and Cycle Zone for Carlton Avenue East, Princess Avenue, Bowling Green Court and Elmstead Avenue which will become live at some point this term.

What does this mean for you?

Cars will not be allowed to drive down or park on the above-mentioned streets between 08:00 and 09:00 and between 14:30 and 16:00 every weekday.

The street will be monitored by cameras and fines will be given to the registered owners of any cars who do not have an exemption to use the road between these times.

Exemptions will be given to the following people:

- Residents that live within the zone
- Blue badge holders that live within the zone
- Emergency services
- Deliveries
- Carers
- Licensed taxis
- School transport & taxi card transport services
- Council operational vehicles (statutory services)
- Medical appointment transport
- Dial-a-ride
- Royal Mail
- Medical practitioner

As soon as I have an exact date for the start of this scheme, I will inform parents immediately. Please use the intervening period to work out your new routine to bring your children to school in the

mornings and to collect in the afternoons. This scheme will make Carlton Avenue East and Elmstead Avenue far safer for all our children as we have seen many poor road use in the past which has put our children and parents at risk of injury.

The Lower School, in collaboration with an outside company, will be opening an after school care club, before the end of September, for anyone who would like to access this provision.

The costs for this provision will be as follows:

15:20 - 16:20 at £8/hour

15:20 - 16:20 at £35/week

15:20 - 17:20 at £13/day

15:20 - 17:20 at £60/week

I will inform parents how they can register for the after school care club as soon as these details have been finalised.
