Dear Parent/Carer.

On behalf of everyone at Preston Manor School, we would like to wish you all a very Happy New Year. I hope that the Christmas holidays provided you with some much needed rest and are now recharged for 2025.

I want to bring to your attention the major road works that are about to start shortly. Major improvements are planned for Wembley High Road. Starting on 13 January 2025, there will be essential road reconstruction work on all sides of Wembley Triangle. After discussions with local traders, TfL, and other stakeholders, the council decided to delay the start date to avoid clashing with the busy Diwali and Christmas periods.

On the Brent website, there is a map showing the closure of Wembley Triangle and parts of Wembley Hill Road, Harrow Road and Wembley High Road. These works are expected to last for 18 weeks. During this period, extensive traffic management will be necessary, allowing access only for buses and emergency service vehicles. I know that this may cause some significant issues in planning journeys to and from school for some of our families so I would urge you to follow the link and plan ahead as best you can.
