

Curriculum Overview - Year 1 - Autumn 2 2025

<p>English Key texts: Room on the Broom and Jack and the Beanstalk. The children will write sentences, spelling common exception words correctly, These are words we have to memorise the spelling of such as: and, the, my, you, he she. Year 1 will read and write familiar and unfamiliar words using sounds already taught (set 1, set 2 and set 3-phonics) Key vocabulary: characters, beginning, middle, end, verb, vocabulary relating to feelings</p>	<p>Maths Addition: Adding numbers within 20. Subtraction: Subtracting numbers within 20. Counting to 20: Count forwards and backwards and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words. Place value within 20: We will be becoming familiar with the idea of splitting numbers into tens and ones. Adding and subtracting within 20: Key vocabulary: add, subtract, tens, ones, <, >, =, less, more, fewer, greater</p>	<p>Science We will be studying every day materials (such as glass, stone, wood or metal) and objects made from these materials. We will use various scientific skills such as investigating, classifying and examining to explore these materials. Key vocabulary: Materials, texture, properties, waterproof, transparent, test, investigate</p>
<p>Religious Education We continue to explore the 'big' question, how did we get here? We explore beliefs from other religions. Key vocabulary God, Allah, Brahman, Atman, creator, heaven, earth</p>	<p>History This term, we are looking at how toys have changed in history starting from the Victorians to present day. We will use secondary sources to explore this. Key Vocabulary Wooden, stone, plastic, metal, past, present, traditional, old, and new</p>	<p>Design Technology Food and mechanisms The children will name and describe fruits and vegetables and explain why they are a fruit or a vegetable. We shall make a moving story book using mechanisms. Key vocabulary: sideways, upwards, mechanism, sliders, design, evaluate</p>
<p>Computing On-line safety Exploring purple Mash We will explore the programme Purple Mash and use these to apply to other subjects</p>	<p>PSHE Keeping and staying healthy: Washing hands Through 'One decision', the children will be presented with video scenarios on staying healthy and they will decide which child is making the right decision</p>	<p>PE 1 Ash has PE on Tuesday (PE teacher) and Thursday (Class teacher) 1 Yew has PE on Monday (Class teacher) and Tuesday (PE teacher)</p>
