

<p>English Key texts: Poems from Ruth Miskin – ‘If I were a hawk’ and ‘I have a cold’ We will learn about adjectives (describing words) and verbs (doing words) in our writing to improve our sentences. We will continue to encourage children to write on the line, making sure all sentences have capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will include common exception words: These are words we have to memorise the spelling of such as, and, the, my, you, he she To read and write familiar and unfamiliar words using sounds already taught (set 1, set 2 and set 3-phonics) Key vocabulary: rhyming words, verse, author, characters, beginning, middle, end, verb, vocabulary relating to feelings</p>	<p>Maths Children will continue to learn about number and place value. We will learn to partition numbers into tens and ones and understand how numbers are made up of these. We will continue counting up to 50 and beyond. The children will do addition and subtraction using a number line and concrete objects to make it more visual for them. Length and height will be investigated. Children will be taught key vocabulary and begin to solve word problems.</p>	<p>Science The children will be learning about the topic of Seasonal Change. They will learn about the seasons and observe the changes across the seasons. They will also look at how the weather changes over the seasons. Key Vocabulary: Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter, months of the year, temperature, days, months and years</p>
<p>Religious Education We will be studying the topic: What is God’s job? Children will learn that our beliefs influence our choices (good/bad) Through stories, children will learn about messages to the world.</p>	<p>Geography Our topic in Geography is the What is the weather like in the UK? Children will learn about seasonal changes in the UK. They will do some fieldwork focusing on compass direction.</p>	<p>Art Children will look at Painting and Mixed Media They will explore colour mixing through paint play, using a range of tools to paint on different surfaces and creating paintings inspired by Clarice Cliff and Jasper Johns.</p>
<p>Computing Children will look at pictograms and Lego Building software. They will learn how to collect the data and make a pictogram. They will continue to learn about online safety and the importance of keeping safe at all times.</p>	<p>PSHE Children will learn about different types of relationships.
