

<p>English Text: This half term, the children will be reading the book, 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' in their Destination Reader and writing lessons. Writing: In writing this half term, the children will continue to write a variety of different genres, including short stories, newspaper articles and formal letters. The children will build on the grammar knowledge they have already developed, including using co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions, apostrophes for contraction and possession and speech punctuation. Reading: This half term, the children will be focusing on the reading skills : inferring and evaluating.</p>	<p>Maths This half term, the children will cover different topics in their maths learning: Times tables: The children will continue to learn by heart the 3, 4, 6 and 8 times tables in preparation for Year 4. Fractions: The children will continue with their fractions learning this half term, including counting in fractions, placing fractions on a number line and identifying equivalent fractions. Mass and capacity: This learning will include measuring in grams and kilograms and comparing different measures.</p>	<p>Science This half term in science, the children will be focusing on the topic, 'Animals Including Humans.' As part of this topic, the children will identify that animals including humans need the right amount and type of nutrition. They will also learn that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. Key vocabulary: nutrition, food, muscles, skeleton, animal, human, protection, movement</p>
<p>Religious Education The topic in RE this half term is 'What if we do wrong.' In this topic, they will explore some Christian beliefs about forgiveness, some beliefs about what happens to the soul after repentance and some Hindu beliefs about how actions can affect the soul.</p>	<p>History This half term, the children will be learning all about the Romans. The children will consider where in history the Roman period was and what else was happening around the world at the same time. They will use a range of sources to find out about the Romans, including how they lived and key events during the time period.</p>	<p>Design and Technology This half term, the children will be focusing on the topic, 'Cooking and nutrition: eating seasonally.' During this topic, the children will be learning all about seasonal food. They will end the topic by creating a seasonal food dish.</p>
<p>Computing This half term, the children will be focusing on touch typing. This will include understanding where different keys are on the keyboard, as well as increasing the speed at which they type.</p>	<p>PSHE This half term, the children will learn about feelings, emotions and mindfulness.</p>	<p>PE This half term, the children will be focusing on striking and fielding games in their outdoor PE lessons.</p>
<p>Music The children's learning this half term will focus around the human body, food and drink.</p>	<p>Modern Foreign Languages: The children will be consolidating and continuing with their Spanish learning this half term.</p>	<p>Please remember...
