Polar -polar describes anything about (or near) the North Pole or South Pole.

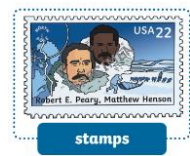
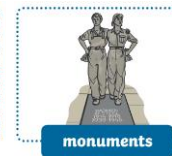
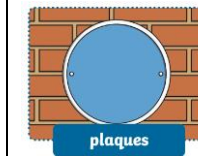
Significant -important and worth knowing about.

Remembering Significant People

Significant people are people who have made important achievements. They are often remembered in different ways.



Sir Ernest Shackleton



Sir Ernest Shackleton was an explorer from the UK, who went to Antarctica three times. His most famous trip was from 1914 to 1917.

Neil Armstrong

Neil Armstrong was an American astronaut. He was the first person to walk on the moon in 1969 during the Apollo 11 mission.



Valentina Tereshkova



Valentina Tereshkova was a Russian astronaut. She was the first woman to go to space. She flew around the Earth by herself in 1963 in a spacecraft called Vostok 6.

Amelia Earhart

Amelia Earhart was an American pilot, who was one of the first women to fly a plane by herself across the Atlantic Ocean.
