

<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Text: This half term, the children will be reading the book, 'Charlotte's Web' by E. B. White in their Destination Reader and writing lessons.</p> <p>Writing: In writing this half term, the children will continue to write a variety of different genres, including short stories, formal letters and non-chronological reports. The children will build on the grammar knowledge they have already developed, including using co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions, apostrophes for contraction and possession and speech punctuation.</p> <p>Reading: This half term, the children will be continuing to focus on the reading skills inferring, summarising and evaluating.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>This half term, the children will cover different topics in their maths learning:</p> <p>Times tables: The children will continue to learn by heart the 3, 4, 6 and 8 times tables in preparation for Year 4.</p> <p>Statistics: The children will learn to read charts and graphs. They will also learn how to draw graphs and charts from data they have collected.</p> <p>Shape: The children will learn about turns and angles and parallel and perpendicular lines. The children will then recognise and describe 2D and 3D shapes.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>This half term in science, the children will continue to focus on the topic, 'Plants.' The children will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants. They will learn about what plants need to grow and they will investigate the way water is transported in plants. Finally, they will explore the part flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed dispersal and seed formation.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: seed, dispersal, formation, pollination, roots, stem, trunk, leaves, flowers, nutrients, light, transported, water</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Religious Education</p> <p>The children will be exploring the symbolism of fire in ceremonies and for remembrance. They will be discussing different ways fire can be used and considering connections. They will also be considering how someone at a Hindu ceremony might feel and what the fire might mean to them. As well as, identifying the role of Shiva's fire in a story and explaining why fire is used in some Zoroastrian ceremonies. They will also think about how they can explain why different Jewish candles might be lit.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>This half term, the children will be learning all about Ancient Egypt.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Design and Technology</p> <p>This half term, the children will explore building structures (castles) through a variety of 2D and 3D shapes.</p>
